From the Health Room

If your child is planning to participate in sports during the 2016-2017 school year, they must have a physical on file in the health room dated after June 1. Please send a note to school requesting a physical form or you can stop by the school to pick one up prior to your summer physical. All medications that are to be administered at school must be accompanied by an ADW authorization form that is to be signed by the physician and the parent. Forms are available in the school office. All meds should be labeled with child's name and dosage. Do not send expired meds to the clinic – they will be returned to you.

The following vaccines are required 16-17 school year:

Kindergarten:

Varicella - two (2) doses of Varicella vaccine are required for Kindergarten.

Grade 7:

Meningococcal (MCV4) – a single dose of MCV4 vaccine and Tdap required for all students entering 7th grade.

All medications should be picked up and signed for from the health room on the last day of school, June 8. If you are not able to pick up meds on the 8th, please call the office to make alternate arrangements.
