Outstanding Tuition/Fees

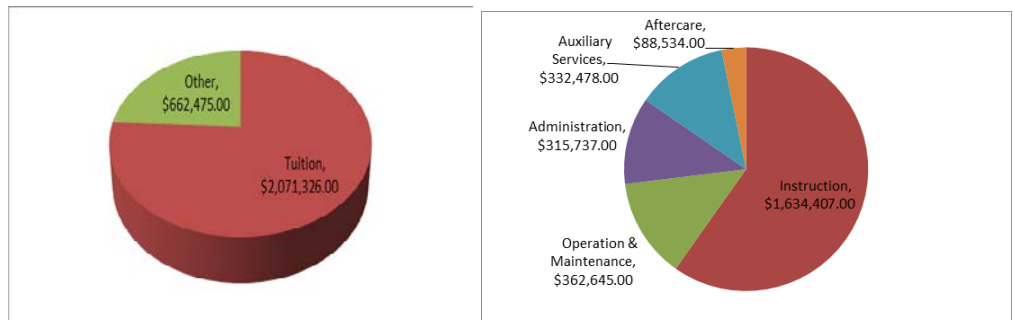
